# How to Make a Two-Handled Shopping Bag

Step 1 — Mark handle placement with Xs at equal distance from each edge (you can use span of hand as a measure).



#### Step 2- Insert handle upside down at X



## Step 3 - Sew handle close to the bottom edge of the top seam



### Step 4 - Flip the handle



### Step 5 - Sew handle again across the top edge of the seam



### Step 5b- sew label on front before proceeding to sew side seams



Step 6- stitch side seams about 3/8- ½ inch from edges, sewing top to bottom. Be sure to reinforce beginning of this seam by going forward and back an inch or so from the top.



#### Step 7 (optional)

#### Make a box pleat for the base

"fluff" bag so that bottom corners make a traingle with side seam going down the center.



Imagine a triangle and sew across the base (width of the base will determine how wide your bag's base will be. )
